RULES FOR USE OF ICE SURFACES

- All skaters using the facility and ice surfaces must have current EFCL skate tag clearly visible on their immediate person (free with community league membership)
- No smoking, No alcohol, and No offensive language permitted
- All skaters under the age of twelve years MUST wear CSA approved helmets and be supervised by persons age sixteen years or older
- No hockey play on Social Skating Rink
- **Mandatory CSA approved helmet on Large Ice Rink for all skaters**
- Ice surfaces will be closed when weather is above 0C and below -25C
- Persons caught vandalizing the facility will be banned from the facility and charged
- All infractions of the rules will be dealt in the manner deemed appropriate by LECL Board Members
- Do not remove any equipment that is provided by LECL

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Update to Membership Purchase

A current year Membership is mandatory to register for any programs.

In an effort to keep our costs to a minimum and ensure that we are using the Membership Dollars in the most productive way, we have chosen to use the EFCL Membership as the ONLY Online membership option.

Effective **January 1, 2018** the LECL.org online eventbrite option will not be available (see Purchase Options below)

You can also purchase a Membership at any Lewis Estates Community League event (payment – cash or cheque, you will receive a paper card for your wallet)

***** Skate Tags: Will be available at events when purchasing a Membership but will no longer be mailed out.... when you and your family arrive at the Rink for Skating the 1st time – present your current year Membership card and you will get skate tags.**

***** Movie Passes: After a survey conducted, the overwhelming response was that the Movie Pass was not necessary – the available discounts on programs and facilities were sufficient.**

EFCL Membership online efcl.org offers you:

- Instant generated Membership # for Program registration (example: Soccer) – you get an email back with the Membership #. (You no longer rely on someone to mail out your card /number)

KEEP IN MIND THIS IS A VOLUNTEER WHO WAS DOING THIS FOR YOU!

- Keeps your Membership # handy at all times... keep email on your phone VS remembering to keep or put the Paper card in your wallet
- Helps us to keep the cost at \$30 and the money is going towards programs and events for you and your family in Lewis Estates (avoids increasing postal costs, smaller number of EFCL paper cards to be purchased)

Purchase Option #1 - Purchase online - Edmonton Federation of Community Leagues (EFCL.org) (Includes an additional \$5 admin fee) \$35 Fill out as much information as possible

Purchase Option #2 - Community Events – will be available to purchase at events – get a paper card \$30

Purchase Option #3 - Servus Credit Unions - in the City of Edmonton now sell community league memberships – using the efcl.org online account (will include the same \$5 admin fee) \$35

Off season access to the Lewis Estates Golf Course

- Lewis Estates Golf Course is NOT a Park, but a privately owned property of Lewis Estates Communities Inc., a subsidiary of Melcor Developments.
- Off Season access is to be regarded as a gesture by Lewis Estates Communities Inc. to provide additional amenity value to LE residents.
- At some locations access will be virtually unrestricted. In others, access may be through a small opening, one that would not be wide enough for anything motorized to pass through. Some entrances will be completely closed.
- Allow for walking dogs on the course provided they are on leash at all times and their handlers pick up after them.
- NO garbage cans will be placed on the course as there is no one other than golf course staff to clear and maintain those garbage cans - garbage will need to be taken home and disposed of.
 - In addition, we intend to lay cross country ski trails when conditions make that practical.

To the Residents of LECL

- **NOTE:** LEGC is not a Park, but a Private Property that should be treated as any other private property in that the users will adhere to guidelines and restrictions as listed above.
- As a resident of LECL who would enjoy access to the GC, your commitment is not only appreciated but a “must” in order to maintain this privilege.
- Lewis Estates Communities Inc., superintendent is supportive of these initiatives and will do his utmost to nurture a harmonious relationship with residents that access the course.
